## White Wine

### Herbert's Sauvignon Blanc - Chile

175 ml/£4.85 – 750ml/£19.00

Fresh and crisp with predominant gooseberry followed by some tropical fruit

### Viognier – Peiriere - France

175 ml/£6.00 – 750ml/£22.00

Light golden, gently aromatic with a bouquet of lingering exotic fruit. Delicious and easy to drink

### Chenin Blanc - Franschoek Cellar - South Africa

175 ml/£6.00 – 750ml/£24.00

Marked out by wonderful rich tropical fruit with overriding Guava flavour, good weight but zesty finish

### Muscadet, de Sevre et Maine - France

175 ml/£6.50 – 750ml/£24.00

Very mineral on the nose with a hint of creaminess. Super fresh and crisp with a dry finish

### Casa del Marqués – Rioja Blanco - Spain

175 ml/£6.75 – 750ml/£27.00

100% Viura. Delicate fruits, clear and fresh with vegetal overtones. On the palate it is light, fresh and well balanced with an intense finish

### Sauvignon Blanc – “Margot” – Chateau Carbonneau - France

175 ml/£6.75 – 750ml/£27.00

Aromas of grapefruit, gooseberry & sweet thyme. Vibrant acidity balances the rich flavours.

### Chardonnay ‘Postales’ Bodegas - del Fin del Mundo – Argentina

175 ml/£7.00 – 750ml/£28.00

This is a great Chardonnay. Barrels of buttery apples that remain fresh and lively due to the great balance of acidity

### Riesling, Villa Wolf - Germany

175 ml/£7.50 – 750ml/£29.00

Marked out by wonderful rich tropical fruit with overriding Guava flavour, good weight but zesty finish

### Picpoul de Pinet – France

175 ml/£7.25 – 750ml/£29.00

Literally translated as ‘lipstinger’...A bouquet of white flowers and lime.

Light, very crisp and clean, delicate lemon and limefruit flavours with a touch of flint

### Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc – Humorous Verse – Margaret River - Australia

175ml/£8.00 - 750ml/£32.00

Passion fruit with hints of jasmine. Freshly zested lemon and lime combined with green asparagus notes. Bright and fresh acidity with a refreshing finish.

### Pinot Gris – Matakana Estate – Marlborough – New Zealand

175ml/£8.50 - 750ml/£34.00

This wine displays lifted aromas of crisp pear, apple and peach. Apple and pear with a hint of lemon zest on the palate. Lovely long finish.

### Sauvignon Blanc – Wild Rock - Marlborough - New Zealand

750ml/£35.00

So classically Marlborough, medium bodied and aromatic with lemon and lime fruit backed up by hints of grass clippings and nettles.

Bursting with flavour in the mouth and with good acidity and length

### Chenin Blanc Avec Chene- Simonsig - South Africa

175ml/£10.00 – 750ml/£38.00

All the hallmarks of a classic Chenin blanc with the added dimension of a little time in oak.

### Petit Chablis - Helene Perrot - Burgundy – France

175 ml/£10.25 – 750ml/£41.00

Light and delicate with citrus fruit characters and a touch of flint

### Gavi di Gavi - ‘Rolona’ Castellari Bergaglio - Piedmont – Italy

750ml/£42.00

White flowers assail which lead to concentrated ripe red apple, nutty flavours. A hint of bitter almond and herbs. Soft and unctuous

## Red Wine

### Herbert's Merlot – Chile

175 ml/£4.85 – 750ml/£18.50

The wine is deep red in colour and releases a powerful, well integrated vanilla and strawberry aroma. The palate is soft and velvety with a long and rich finish

### Cabernet Sauvignon - Atacama - Central Valley - Chile

175 ml/£5.25 – 750ml/£21.00

Rich blackcurrant, cassis and blackberry flavours with a hint of leafiness. Soft, soft tannins with a clean finish

### Montepulciano - Italy

175 ml/£6.00 – 750ml/£22.00

Intense ruby colour, grape scented intense and fruity, made from hand-selected Montepulciano grapes

### Merlot/Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon - Flagtree - Patagonia – Argentina

175 ml/£6.25 – 750ml/£25.00

Plum jam, blackcurrant and damson mark out this upfront juice explosion of ripeness. Balanced by good acidity and a hint of cedar

### Carmenere, Chile

175 ml/£7.00 – 750ml/£26.00

Lovely red purple. Aromas of chocolate, plum, violet and spice

### Merlot/Cabernet Franc, Bordeaux, France

175 ml/£7.25 – 750ml/£28.00

Bright with hints of vanilla and soft tannins, very drinkable wine. Complex and longer on the palate

### Malbec - ‘Postales’ Bodegas - del Fin del Mundo – Argentina

175 ml/£7.25 – 750ml/£29.00

Dark, dark fruit, great intensity with a good measure of spice.

Supple tannins, undertones of tobacco and vanilla lead to a lingering mellow character

### Rioja Sin Crianza - Paco Garcia – Spain

175 ml/£7.75 – 750ml/£31.00

100% Tempranillo aged for 6 months in low toast French oak barrels.

Strawberry and black cherry aromas on the nose.

Full and rich on the palate with damson and violet fruit flavours and hints of chocolate and spice.

### Shiraz – Bibliotheque Travel Writing - McLaren Vale - Australia

175 ml/£7.75 – 750ml/£31.00

Deep crimson with purple hues followed by lifted blood plum and blackberries and pepper spice on the nose. The palate begins with blackberry sweet fruit and finishes with oak tannin.

### Pinot Noir - Newen- Patagonia – Argentina

175 ml/£8.25 – 750ml/£33.00

Very fruity aroma with notes of morello cherries and caramel. Sweet and fruity in the mouth with soft tannins, silky and well balanced

### Zinfandel – Beyers Ranch – Wente Vinyards – California - USA

175 ml/£9.35 – 750ml/£37.00

This Zinfandel has aromas of raspberry, cherry, vanilla and strawberry jam. With medium tannins and rich mouth filling bark fruit flavours with a hint of oak.

### Pinot Noir – Matakana Estate – Marlborough – New Zealand

750ml/£38.00

Wonderful aromas of cherry and strawberry with a hint of oak, berries explode on the palate with a long lingering finish

### Pinotage - Diemersfontein - Western Cape – South Africa

175 ml/£10.35 – 750ml/£42.00

Velvety smooth with hints of freshly ground coffee, dark chocolate, plum and ripe black cherry. In one word “WOW”

### Syrah – Black Elephant – Vaucluse - France

750ml/£47.00

100% Hand-picked Syrah fermented and aged in new oak barrels. Gathers power and character with robust jam-laden dark fruits, leather and spice

## Rose Wine

### Méli Mélo- St Martin des Champs - France

175 ml/£6.25 – 750ml/£25.00

Redcurrant and raspberries with a hint of cream. Ripe fruit but light, fresh and a crisp finish

### Rose ‘n Roll - St. Martin – France

750ml/£32.00

Beautiful salmon pink with an almost onion skin colour. Delicate and subtle with flavours of peach and strawberry

## Dessert wine

### De Bortoli VAT 5 Botrytis Semillon, Australia

75ml/£5 – 375ml/24

### Sauternes Ch. Lafon Bordeaux, France

75ml/£7.00 - 375ml/34
